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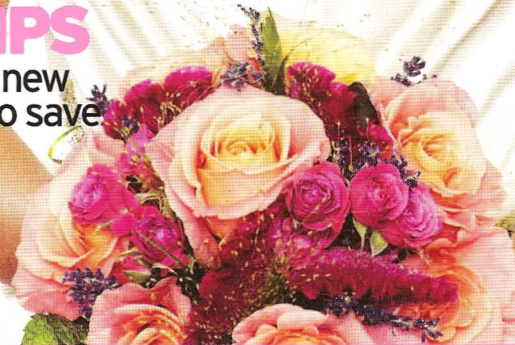

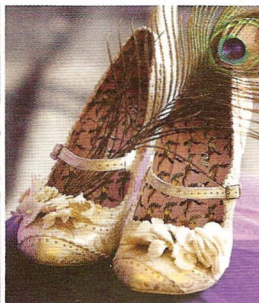

having traditional centrepieces, I wanted to have wild flowers in an assortment of old glass containers on the tables.”

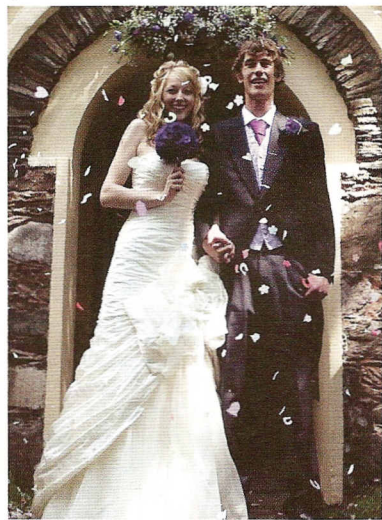
Fashion forward

Personal touches

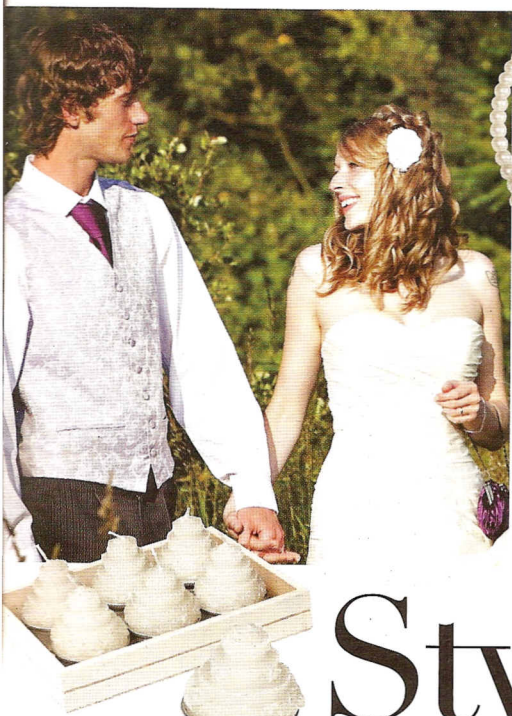
Jennifer and George loved how their marquee reception allowed them to make the day personal to them. “All our family got involved in setting everything up, which was very special,”
